

Warren County Sheriff Office along with the Kentucky Office of Highway Safety presented an impaired Driving event to the junior and senior class at South Warren High School. Over 60 students were given the chance to drive a golf cart through a winding course set up with traffic cones. The Kentucky Office of Highway Safety program is called "3-D (Drunk and Drugged Driving) Simulator" which allows students to wear "Fatal Vision" goggles that impair their ability to drive. These goggles simulate the effects of impaired driving to the students.

The Kentucky Office of Highway Safety has a roll over simulator they use to demonstrate the effects of not wearing a seatbelt during a rollover collision which was also brought to South Warren High School to show the immense effects to the students.
