

GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL MEETS TONIGHT

The Glasgow City Council has a number of items on the agenda tonight. The Glasgow Fire Department's annual report will be given by Chief Tony Atwood, as well as the City of Glasgow Police Department annual report presented by Chief Guy Turcotte. There will be second reading of an ordinance that creates the stormwater fund, and first reading of three ordinances that add proper to the city limit boundaries, as well as one that accepts two streets into the city. The council also plans to declare certain property as surplus and will approve an auction on March 9th to sell the equipment. The meeting is at 7 pm in the Council Chambers downtown.
