

METCALFE COUNTY GRAND JURY RETURNS TWO INDICTMENTS

The Metcalfe County Grand Jury met recently and returned two indictments.

Thirty-three year old Christopher Posey of Albany has been indicted for Theft by Failure to Make Required Disposition of Property \$500 or more but less than \$10,000. The grand jury charges that on or about May 4, 2012 in Metcalfe County Posey obtained property and intentionally dealt with the property as his own and failed to make the required payment or disposition. His arraignment is set for February 26.

Twenty-two year old James W. Robertson of Edmonton was indicted for three counts of Burglary, 3rd degree; four counts of Theft by Unlawful Taking, under \$500 and being a Persistent Felony Offender, 1st degree. The grand jury charges that on or about December 26 or 27, 2012, Robertson committed the crime of burglary, 3rd degree when knowingly entered or remained in buildings with the intent to commit a crime. On the same dates, he took or exercised control over the moveable property of others with the intent to deprive the owners thereof. Robertson is now being charged as a Persistent Felony Offender, 1st degree, due to previous arrests in 2008, 2010 and 2011. Robertson Arraignment date has been set for February 13, 2013.
