

Two men arrested for drug charges following accident on Burkesville Road

The Barren County Sheriff's Department arrested two Tompkinsville residents Friday night while investigation a traffic accident on Burkesville Road. Deputy Adam Bow responded to the accident and detected an odor of marijuana coming from one of the vehicles. After speaking to the occupants of the vehicle, it was determined that the subjects had removed some marijuana from the wrecked vehicle into another vehicle at the scene. Consent to search the vehicle was given by the driver. In the glove box of the vehicle Deputy Bow located a large baggie that contained 8 smaller baggies of suspected crack cocaine. In the truck of the car Deputy Bow also found a bag containing suspected marijuana. 29-year-old Vincent Patterson, and 30-year-old James Smith, both of Tompkinsville were arrested and charged with; possession of marijuana, trafficking in controlled substance 1st degree, and tampering with physical evidence. Both were lodged in the Barren County Corrections Center.

Man and Women arrested after firearms found at residence

The Barren County Sheriff's Department responded to a domestic disturbance Sunday at 2787 Etoile Road. Deputies were called due to an altercation between 51 year old Jeffrey A. Heinrichs, and 53 year old Pamela D. Frey. While investigating the altercation, Deputy Adam Bow discovered two .22 caliber rifles in the residence. Deputy Bow later confirmed that both Heinrichs and Frey were both convicted felons out of the state of Florida. Both Hienrichs and Frey were arrested and charged with; possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. They were both lodged in the Barren County Corrections Center. Deputy Aaron Bennett assisted in the investigation.
