

MAN ARRESTED ON SUNDAY FROM DRUG COMPLAINT

On Sunday March 10th at 5:25 pm, Glasgow Police received a drug complaint on a Gray Grand AM. Upon contacts, 26-year-old Dale Harder of Glasgow was a passenger inside the vehicle. While speaking with Harder, Police informed him of the Drug Complaint. He stated that he had nothing on his person. Police asked the subject to empty his pockets. While doing so, 5 white pills, and a silver in color tube fell to the ground. Poison control identified the pills as Hydrocodone; a schedule 3 narcotic. Harder was arrested and transported to the Barren County Jail. Harder was charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Possession of a controlled substance, 2nd degree, drug unspecified.
