

FEMALE FUGITIVE ARRESTED YESTERDAY IN HORSE CAVE

On Wednesday, April 03, 2013, Kentucky State Police Troopers Ronnie Reynolds and Daniel White apprehended 32-year-old Faith D. Priddy of Bonnieville, Kentucky. An extensive search had been conducted for Ms. Priddy, when she was located and arrested in Horse Cave and lodged in the Hart County Jail.

She was charged with a parole violation warrant for absconding parole supervision, failing to complete treatment for substance abuse, and failing to report to a parole officer as directed.

The original conviction charges out of Hardin County were for manufacturing methamphetamine, controlled substance endangerment to a child, 4th degree, and possessing a controlled substance, 1st degree, 1st offense (drug unspecified).
