

MAN ARRESTED IN BONNIEVILLE AFTER PURSUIT

Kentucky State Police attempt to serve a felony arrest warrant on Darnell Shipp of Bonnieville, Kentucky for violating probation.

When troopers arrived at the residence, Shipp fled into the woods in an attempt to evade the police. He was caught about 30 yards into the woods and arrested on the warrant. Troopers also found a concealed plastic container of methamphetamine on Shipp.

Darnell Ship was charged with possession of a firearm by a convicted felon and possession of marijuana, possession of a controlled substance, 1st degree, 1st offense (drug unspecified), tampering with physical evidence, fleeing or evading police, 2nd degree, (on foot), and being a persistent felony offender. Shipp was lodged in the Hart County Jail.
