

HIT AND RUN YESTERDAY IN WARREN COUNTY

On Thursday, June 27th at 11:52 pm, the Warren County Sheriff's Office responded to a call of a hit and run collision on Mt. Olivet Road. Upon arrival to the park, Deputies made contact with the victim, Diana Bond. Ms. Bond stated to Deputies that her residence had been burglarized. The suspect struck Ms. Bond's vehicle while fleeing from the scene. Through the investigation, the vehicle and driver were later located and identified as 40-year-old Teresa Greer of Bowling Green. Greer denied involvement in the incident however some of the stolen property was later recovered from Ms. Greer's residence at lot 23. The stolen property was returned to the owner. Greer is lodged in the Warren County Regional Jail and charged with Burglary Second Degree.
