33 year old Austin Lee Sprowls of Cloyd Road in Tompkinsville has been indicted on the following eight counts: CRIMINAL POSSESSION OF A FORGED INSTRUMENT, POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 2ND DEGREE, two separate counts of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 3

and PERSISTENT FELONY OFFENDER 1

DEGREE. All charges are a result of an event in August of this year.

31 year old Stephanie Rhea Gillock Sturgeon of Mammoth Cave Road in Park City has been indicted on three counts: MARIJUANA CULTIVATION, FIVE OR MORE PLANTS, POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA and PERSISTENT FELONY OFFENDER 2

DEGREE. All charges stem from an event in late June.
