

GLASGOW POLICE OFFICERS MAKE TWO ARRESTS

According to Julie Anne Williams, Public Affairs Officer with the Glasgow Police Department:

On Tuesday night, just before 9:00, Glasgow Police Officers responded to the intersection of North Front Street and Broadway in Glasgow

, in reference to a complaint of a female passed out in a silver car.

Upon arrival, Officers located the female, who was asleep in her vehicle, and observed a small clear baggie of suspected cocaine laying beside her gear shift.

Officers made contact with the driver, 29 year old Kakeeya Jaree Tooley of Quail Ridge Circle in

, and as Tooley exited the vehicle officers noticed a strong smell of alcohol.

Tooley was arrested and charged with OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL/DRUGS 1
