The Fiscal Court meeting conducted regular business as usual. The Court adopted a resolution to codify its more than 500 ordinances with American Legal Publishing, Incorporated. County Attorney, Jeff Sharp said it will provide a much-needed organization and will be a service to the citizens.

Also, the court voted to close a portion of Squire Edwards Road...some .95 miles in length. Magistrate Tommy Matthews said the citizens "wanted it left alone."
