

A recent session of the Barren County Grand Jury has resulted in the following indictments:

Included on a single indictment were 50 year old Halious H. Isbell of Scottsville and 35 year old Tracy J. Mitchell of Bowling Green. Both face charges of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 1ST DEGREE, POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 2ND DEGREE, POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA AND POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA.

Additionally, Isbell faces charges of OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, OPERATING A MOTOTR VEHICLE WHILE LICENSE IS REVOKED OR SUSPENDED FOR DUI 2ND OFFENSE and POSSESSING OF OPEN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IN A MOTOR VEHICLE. Bail was listed at \$5000 cash or approved surety.

Due to events in late March of this year, 23 year old Dustin Tyler Vibbert and 23 year old James Tyler Bray along with 33 year old Barbara Ann Stilts of Park City were indicted on counts of POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA and POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA.

Additionally, Vibbert faces charges of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 1ST DEGREE 2ND OFFENSE, Bray faces an additional charge of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 1ST DEGREE. Stilts faces additional charges of POSSESSION OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE 3RD DEGREE. No bail amount was listed on the indictment.

An indictment is an accusation only and all individuals should be considered as innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
