

Forty-three-year-old Christopher T. Mills of Knob Lick was arrested by the Glasgow Police Department last night and charged with operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol or drugs second offense, possession of an open alcohol beverage container in a motor vehicle and reckless driving.
