

**Donald Edwin Hendley**, 76, Glasgow, died Tuesday, January 10, 2012, at his residence. A native of Plainfield, IN, he was a son of the late Berlin Holmes Hendley and Lettie Delmas Claspell Hendley, both of whom were Barren & Monroe County natives. He was a Tool and Die Engineer, having worked at Statek in Orange, California, and was a United States Navy Veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving aboard the USS Oriskany.
