

Paul Hoskins, age 89, of St. Lucie Village and longtime Fort Pierce, Florida, dentist passed away on September 14, 2013.

Paul was born in Cowley, Wyoming, on May 22, 1924, and moved to Morgantown, West Virginia, in 1926 where he and his family remained for several years. He graduated from Morgantown High School, attended Mercersburg Academy, graduated from West Virginia University, and earned his D.D.S. degree from the University Of Pittsburg School Of Dentistry in 1947.
